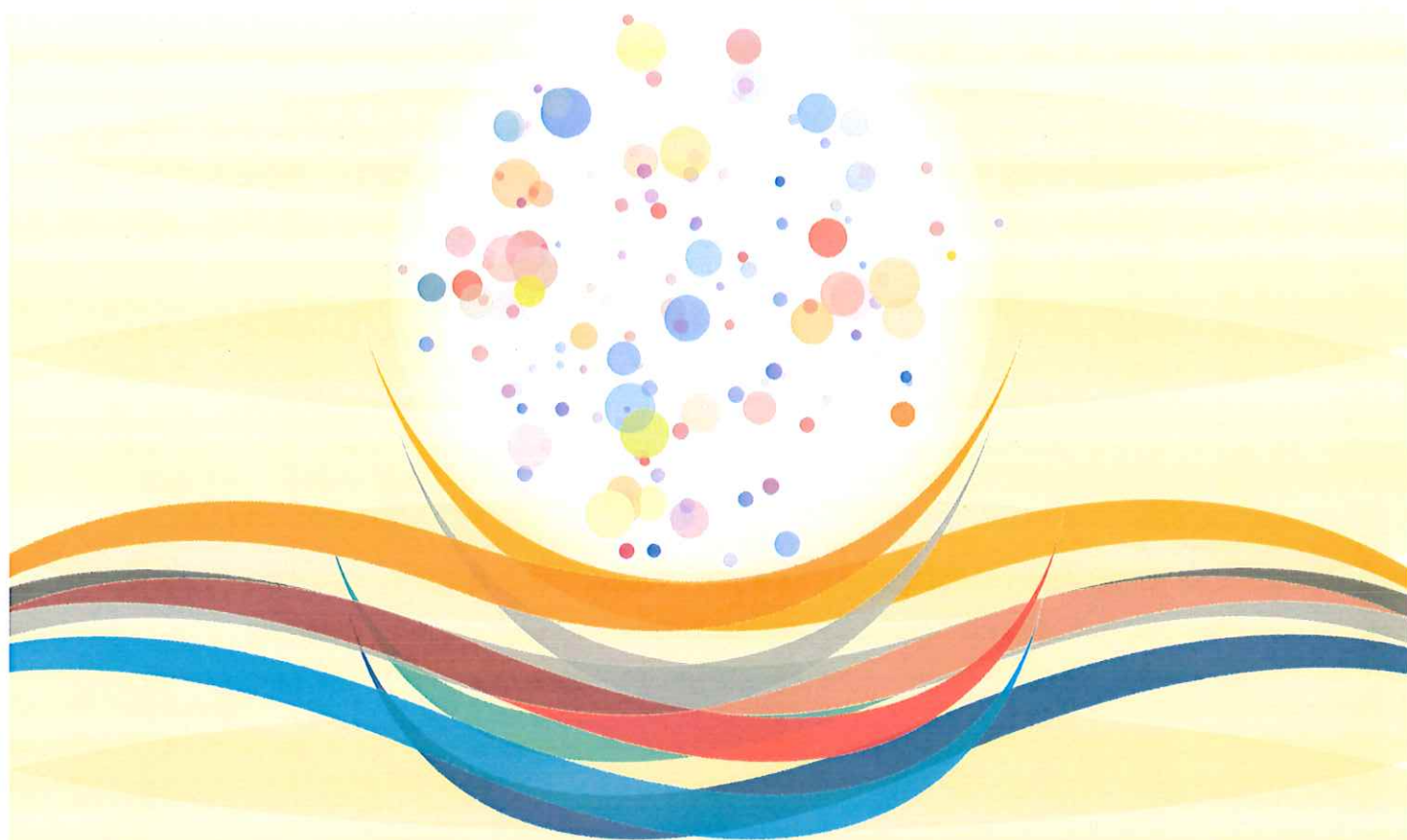

## Rotary Club of Taipei – English Speech Contest

The English Speech Contest (ESC) is hosted by the Rotary Club of Taipei (RCT). The club is now in its 70th year of service to the community. The ESC is in its 63rd year having begun modestly in 1955, when the Rotary Club of Taipei sponsored two separate oratory competitions celebrating the theme that "He profits most who serves the best". The following year saw the birth of the Inter-Collegiate English Oratory Contest which evolved to the current ESC format. Open to students at Taiwan ROC's universities, the ESC continues to be a major service activity of the Rotary Club of Taipei. Over the years, thousands of students have benefited from the opportunities provided by the competition and have continued on to important professional and community leadership positions.

This years ESC topic is **Youth-Driven Social Entrepreneurship**.

As with past ESC events, the core objectives of this contest will stay focused on *Improving Leadership Skills, Confidence and Communication Skills*. This years topic will also urge participants to focus on social issues that require proper solutions. Promoting *Entrepreneurial Skills* as well.

Social enterprise is about changing the world through business. Social enterprises exist and trade not to maximize private profit, but to further their social and environmental initiatives. In short, social enterprise is about business where everyone profits.

RCT would like to to hear from you, the youth of Taiwan. Tell us about an idea that you have to better the community, or the world, that you live in.

The main Rotary Areas of Focus are listed below. Use these main categories to properly organize your idea for the contest.

- Peace and conflict prevention/resolution
- Disease prevention and treatment
- Water and sanitation
- Maternal and child health

- Basic education and literacy
- Economic and community development

## Timeline

### Workshop: April 14th, 2018

- This workshop will focus on Public Speaking / Presentation, An Introduction to Social Entrepreneurship and Social Business Model Canvas development.
- Applicants are encouraged to attend this session as to receive mentorship in addition to detailed contest insight.
- Workshop location will be in Taipei. *The exact location to be determined later:*

### Application Deadline: May 5th, 2018

- Complete applications must be received no later than May 5th, 2018.

### First Round Selection Notification: May 12th, 2018

- Applicants who have been selected to advance to the Grand Finale will be notified.
- Those selected must be available to attend the Grand Finale event or face disqualification.

### Grand Finale Date: May 26, 2018

- Event day.
- Select applicants will compete against one another throughout the day. (8AM – 3PM)
- Contest Location: Chingshin Elementary and Middle School (台北私立靜心小學)
- Address: XingLongRoad ,Section 2 No. 46, WenShan District, Taipei (台北市興隆路二段46號)
- Near: Wanlong MRT station (捷運萬隆站)

## Submission Requirements

### Qualification

All applicants **must**:

- be citizens of the Republic of China;
- be enrolled in a Taiwanese college or university as an undergraduate or graduate student at the time of registration

### Individuals and Teams

- Applicants can choose to register either as an individual or a 2-4 person team.
- If registering as a team, then a team name should be selected and provided during registration.

### First Round (Documents)

- The Concept Slide Deck and Executive Summary written in English.
- The Executive Summary should be no more than five pages including appendices.
- The set of documents should include the following:
  1. Concept Slide Deck (5 slides)
  2. Executive Summary (1 page)
  3. Appendices (3-4 pages)
    - List of stakeholders with details of their needs (E.g., beneficiaries, partnerships, investors, etc.)
    - Individual, or Team, Resume
    - Business Model Canvas

### Grand Finale Presentations

- Individuals, or teams, will be selected as Finalists and compete on **May 26, 2018**.
- If you decide to enter as a team, then all members of each team must be present at the presentation. Any absentee from each team may constitute disqualification unless having prior written approval from RCT.
- Each individual, or team, will have **5 minutes** of presentation without interruption from the judges. Immediately following each presentation, judges will engage team members in a **5 minute** question / answer session.
  - This will happen in two stages the day of the event.
    - Round one will happen in judging classrooms.
    - Round two will happen in the main auditorium in front of judging panel and a larger audience.
- It is compulsory for all team members to speak in the presentation, and each member is also required to show up on stage and participate in the whole event.
- The presentation may include any audio and visual aids that the team considers appropriate.
- RCT will provide a computer with PowerPoint software and projector to assist your presentation. Any team requiring proprietary software and equipment to demonstrate their plan is responsible for its provision and installation.

## Judging

Judging takes place in two rounds:

**First Round** – Concept and Executive Summary Submission

**Grand Finale** – In-person pitch to judging panel, potential investors

There will be a panel of judges for each of the two stages. Each panel will be made up of Rotarians, educators, executives, business owners, philanthropists, venture capitalists, professors and social entrepreneurs.

The best plan is the one that judges believe will generate the greatest social good, subject to feasibility. Not only should the idea be attractive in terms of its potential for social value creation, but the plan must also be practical in terms of the likelihood of achieving success. The judges will consider the following criteria:

#### Concept

The concept should reflect an innovative, feasible approach to solve a serious social problem. The team should demonstrate a clear understanding of the issues it seeks to address and the economic and social drivers of the problem and its solution.

#### People

The individual, or team, should demonstrate that it has or is able to acquire relevant skills, contacts, and expertise in order to accomplish its goals. The individual, or team, should be credible in communicating the plan and its feasibility.

#### Social Impact

Though it is not necessary to compute quantified measures of the social impact, the team must be able to qualify the theory of change, that is, to define the impact value chain by illustrating how your business inputs, activities and outputs can generate outcomes and subsequent impact that aligned with your initial mission and goals.

#### Sustainability

The business model should be sustainable for the period of time consistent with achieving the desired social impact. The plan's final projected year may involve ending the business, continuing operations at a constant level, stable growth, transferring ownership and control or replicating the business in other locations.

### Prizes

Winners of the 2018 ESC will receive direct mentorship and seed funding for their social enterprise. Winners will also be eligible for internships facilitated by RCT and its affiliate organizations.



# Rotary Club of Taipei - English Speech Contest Registration

## Qualification:

### 1. All applicants must:

- (i) be citizens of the Republic of China and not possess any other passport at the time of registration;
- (ii) be enrolled in a Taiwanese college or university as an undergraduate or graduate student at the time of registration;

2. Failure to meet any of the above requirements will result in disqualification and the return of any and all prizes, gifts, tokens and benefits received, or arising from, the competition. In the event a participant is disqualified, the immediate runner-up will succeed to the position of the disqualified participant.

3. Prizes are non-transferable and may not be returned for cash or exchanged for other items. You must be available to undertake travel on the date, time and at the location, as designated by Rotary Club of Taipei without being accompanied by your parents, relatives, friends or any other person(s). Failing to meet those requirements, your prize will be forfeited without compensation to you, and you will be responsible for damages caused to Rotary Club of Taipei.

4. You agree that any photographs or video-recordings taken of you during the ESC can be used to promote the ESC event and the general purposes of Rotary Club of Taipei. Should you disagree with this requirement, you must inform the Rotary Club of Taipei in writing before your signing or submitting of the Registration form.

5. The winners of the ESC shall act as ambassadors of the Rotary Club of Taipei and shall abide by the rules and requirements set up by the Rotary Club of Taipei and the host Rotary clubs and/or families for the duration of the program. Failure to meet such rules and requirements will result in disqualification, early termination of travel and return of prizes. The disqualified winner(s) shall be responsible for damages caused to the Rotary Club of Taipei.

6. If the applicant is under 20 years of age, his/her application must be accompanied by a consent statement, signed by the parents or legal custodians. This consent statement must detail the approval of the application in a separate email to the Rotary Club of Taipei or if the application is submitted in hard copy, the parents or custodians consent must be stated next to the signature of the applicant.

## 參賽資格：

### 1. 參賽者需符合下列條件:

- (i) 具有中華民國國籍且無雙重國籍者
  - (ii) 目前就讀於國內各大專院校之在學學生(含研究所)
2. 違反上述規定者將被取消參賽資格及優勝資格，所有獎項、獎品、贈品、優惠等皆應退還予台北扶輪社。其優勝資格，將由名次在後者依序遞補。
3. 獎品不可轉讓予他人亦不得變換現金或其他物，得獎者必須依台北扶輪社所安排之日期及時間前往指定之國家或地點，得獎者在國外之期間亦不得由父母、親屬，或其他人作陪。違反此規定者以棄權論，不得請求任何補償。得獎者並須對台北扶輪社因此所受之損害負賠償責任。
